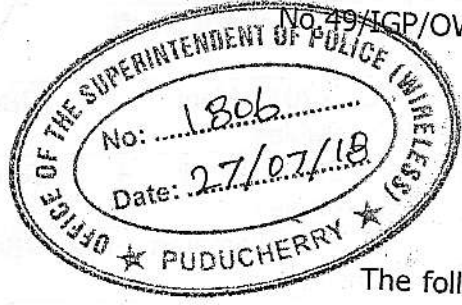

ORDER

Sub: Action Plan to prevent illegal sand mining.

The following Action Plan is issued with immediate effect in order to prevent illegal sand mining, especially reported within the PS limits of Villianur, Thirukkanur & Bahour. It will be in the form of deployment of both local Police and IRBn in the affected areas. They shall patrol the areas in an effective manner.

Time of Duty :

The Day Shift will be between 0800 hours & 2000 hours and the Night Shift will be between 2000 hours & 0800 hours on the next day. Check points and patrolling parties to be fully equipped with wireless sets and necessary equipments.

Deployment of Men:

The local Police as mentioned above along with 2 PCs of IRBn. each shall be posted in those areas/Check Points by the SHOs concerned without fail. The local Police shall be equipped with lathy and walkie-talkie set. In case, deployed local PC is changed, concerned SHO shall immediately inform the name and number of said PC to the i/c. control room.

Deployment of IRBn. :

DC (Adj.), IRBn. shall depute the required strength of IRBn. to report to the SHOs concerned for this purpose. The IRBn. Men shall be equipped with necessary arms & ammunition.

Action plan and surprise element:-

- In every affected Police Stations, points have been selected which are affected by sand mining.
- Two points each in affected PS can be selected for daily deployment.
- SSP(L&O) will decide the points and daily deployment and inform control room.
- SSP(L&O) shall daily give the deployment/prevention report twice (once day & once night) daily.

Reporting :

- a) On receipt of any information/complaint from Dial 100 or 1031, the SHO, CI & SP concerned shall visit the spot at once and verify such information/complaint for initiating necessary action. It is the responsibility of the SHO, CI & SP concerned to prevent this menace. SSP(L&O) shall cross check these calls daily on random basis. SSP(L&O) to personally visit once to verify this and check deployment.
- b) **During day time**, the SHOs concerned shall give situation report on this menace to the Police Control Room **every three hours**.
- c) **During night time**, the Incharge Officer, Police Control Room shall take the **hourly report** from the above Check Points, Night Rounds GO/Inspector and the respective Police Station. SSP(L&O) shall check the deployment once in a week in night time and shall inform the control room about the same.
- d) It shall be the responsibility of SHOs and SP Sub-division to prevent this menace. SSP(L&O) shall ensure the compliance of this.
- e) Case relating to illegal sand mining / theft to be treated as SR cases
- f) SSP shall personally monitor the investigation of such case.
- g) Dossier / Files to be opened for the offenders involved in sand mining theft. Their activities to be observed.
- h) Information to be collated about their involvement in such illegal activities.
- i) SHOs to hold community liaisoning meeting to make public aware about the sand mining theft.
- j) SP(Wireless) to ensure sufficient wireless sets are available for implementation of plan. He will also brief staff in control room for proper communication of calls, checking of deployment / situation report and confirmation of visits to place of calls by SHO/CI/SP/SSP.

Co-ordination with Revenue officials:-

- a) SSP(L&O) to co-ordinate with Collector, Puducherry for stringent action against illegal sand mining / theft.
- b) Concerned SPs and SHOs to co-ordinate on daily basis with Deputy Collector (Revenue) concerned and teams tasked for action against sand mining theft.
- c) Control room shall also immediately give information relating to sand mining theft to concerned revenue officials / Raid teams and also record the action taken / response by them if any.

This arrangement shall be personally supervised by SSP(L&O) under the overall supervision of IGP, Puducherry.
