Dear

Of late, many incidents of child sexual abuse/assault (CSA) are being reported frequently in the media. Such incidents have very serious physical and mental health consequences on the survivors. Besides severe physiological trauma, victims of CSA may suffer serious injuries and even permanent physical damage like mutilation, paralysis and reduce the survivor to a permanent vegetative state. Some victims may be exposed to the risk of HIV/AIDS, unwanted pregnancy, etc. These victims, below the age of 18 may belong to any gender and need urgent help.

2. It is very important that victims of CSA are attended to immediately and provided all the required services, at the earliest. Some States have also established centres in hospitals to provide immediate comprehensive services to such victims. Keeping this in mind, NCPCR, has constituted a team under the Member, NCPCR to visit the victims at the earliest in order to reassure the victims and ensure that the victims receive the required attention and timely treatment, as provided under POCSO Act, 2012.

3. Such initiatives play a pivotal role in ensuring speedy justice to the victims by getting their complaints properly registered at Police Stations; deliver urgently needed services; emotional and financial support and counselling. Services for medical and legal assistance, help the investigators and forensic experts to provide holistic and rehabilitative care to the victim and his/her family. They also help in installing confidence and faith in vulnerable victims / witnesses to access justice.

4. Keeping the seriousness and gravity of the issue in mind, I request you to constitute multi disciplinary teams at the State and District level to take suo-motu cognizance of any


