Dear Shri Manoj Parida,

Special Protection Group, established under an Act of Parliament, is entrusted with the responsibility of providing proximate security to the Prime Minister of India as well as former Prime Ministers & their family members. Being a 100% deputationist organization, SPG officers are drawn from CAPFs and State/U.T Police Forces of the country.

As(Home)

2. The representation of State Police officers in SPG at present is less than 1%. Prime Minister has desired that SPG may be adequately represented by States/UTs. State Police officers will not only add to the overall capacity of SPG to provide fool proof proximate security to Protectees, but also strengthen the capacity building of VIP security contingent of a State Police Force when trained manpower returns to States from SPG in due course. There is a need for the States/UTs to have trained manpower who are exposed to latest technology, techniques as well as equipments used in VIP security along with national and international exposure to protect high dignitaries in the State.

3. It is proposed to induct Police Officers/personnel from your U.T in the ranks of SIs/Inspectors(Graduates)/ SIs/Insp.(Technical/ Communication/ Tele-Communication Radio or Wireless Operator/computer programmer) (Graduates with Science)/ Constables/Head Constables/(Driver)(10th or equivalent qualification with valid driving licence) in SPG. Post induction, these officers will undergo extensive and rigorous (including psychological) training in SPG before actual deployment in VVIP security duties.

4. The selected officers will have to serve SPG for a minimum period of three years (normal deputation tenure in SPG is 6 years), after which they can opt to return to their States. The age criteria and other eligibility conditions as well as the physical standards they would be expected to maintain, will be as per Annexure-I attached. A list of incentives being provided to Officers on deputation to SPG is also enclosed at Annexure-II. Incentives mainly include Special Security Allowance upto 55% of basic pay for ops personnel, Rs. 27,800/- per annum for uniforms for ops officers, HRA/official quarters, world class gym, swimming pool, ration money as applicable in parent Deptt, free transport facilities upto duty place, six hourly duties, Central Police Canteen & Kendriya Vidyalaya within SPG residential complex, Dwarka, New Delhi. I am confident that this temporary transfer of manpower/deputation would, in the long run, be an investment in capacity building of the State Police Force, as on their return they can be professionally utilized for specialized VIP protection, training, and for any combat situation. The professional expertise, knowledge and skill gained while serving in SPG will be in the long run strengthen the security architecture of the State/U.Ts.




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5. I therefore request you to please send at least 50 nominations of Officers of the rank indicated in para -3 above, who are clear from vigilance angle, with no Departmental action pending/ contemplated against them (preferably who have served at least 5 years of service including training). The nominated officers will have to appear for pre-induction tests conducted by SPG. It is our experience that only 20-25% of nominated officers are selected for induction into SPG as the selection criteria, which include psychological tests, are very stringent.
