



MINUTES OF THE MEETING ON ALLOTMENT FISH STALLS FOR
FISHERMEN AT UZHAVARSANDHAI BY AGRICULTURE DEPARTMENT,
HELD ON 25.06.2010 AT 11.00 A.M.

A meeting was convened by the Sub-Collector Revenue (North) as per the directions of the Collector-cum-Special Secretary to Govt. in the Chamber of the Sub-Collector (Revenue) North regarding allotment of fish stalls for fishermen at Uzhavar Sandhai By Agriculture Department,

The following issues were discussed and deliberated upon:-

1. The sub-collector requested the officials of Agriculture Department to allot the 26 stalls on the Southern side of the Agriculture Department entrance gate to fish vendors. Presently there is space constraints in the Big Market as fish stalls which are inadequate to cater the needs of the growing number of fish vendors and people buying fish.

2. The Officers from Agriculture Department while agreeing for sparing the stalls has raised apprehension that since the Agricultural complex is situated in the Botanical Garden and the visiting tourists may be disturbed by the smell emanating from the fish waste products lying in the area. Therefore, they have insisted for cleaning the premises in and around all the 26 stalls. Further, a nominal fees shall also be collected from each stall as in the case of other vegetable vendors by the Agriculture Department.

3. The Fisheries Department has agreed to clean up the premises to avoid stench from the fish waste. A water tap connection is to be extended by the Agriculture Department for this purpose. Moreover, it was agreed that the place has to be used by the wholesale fish vendors and all the stalls around the premises shall wind up their business before 7.00 A.M. every day.

4. The Police authorities may ensure that there shall not be any unnecessary stocking of fish materials beyond the prescribed hours and also to enforce the above points agreed in the meeting.
