## CAR WINDOW-BREAK CASES BUSTED : 10 CASES SOLVED

A spate of incidents of 'car window-break' was reported in the last few months in Puducherry. Necessary preventive measures were taken by intensifying Police patrolling, vehicle checking, laying of traps, etc., to contain this type of offence.

On 25.07.18, the team comprising of Inspector Senthilkumar, Inspector/STF Karthikeyan, SI/STF Ramesh, SI Vetrivel, SI Murugan, SI/STF Santhosh and Men of STF & Grand Bazaar Police Station, under the supervision of SP(East) C. Maran were on rounds in white town area. During that time, Shri. Prakash, r/o Maduravoil, Chennai reported the Police that after parking his Car near Govt. General Hospital, Puducherry, he went for lunch. When he returned back to take his car, he found a person attempting to break the window of his Car to commit theft of his laptop, kept in the Car. He was caught red-handed and handed over to the Police.

On tactful interrogation, the identity of the person came to know as **Prasanth @ Sabari(26)** S/o Tamilarasan, 8th Cross, Milk Colony, Ramji Nagar, Trichy, Tamilnadu. He was immediately arrested. He confessed to the crime. The confession revealed that he alongwith four other persons of Ramji Nagar, Trichy have committed the offence. So far, all the five accused persons have involved in 8 such cases in Puducherry and 2 cases in Karaikal. The absconding four accused persons will be arrested at the earliest.
