**MEMORANDUM**

Sub:- DHFWS – Issue of Wound Certificate for MLC cases –  
Instructions issued.

Ref:- Letter No.05/DIGP/OW/2011-269 dated 10.08.2011 of  
Dy. Inspector General of Police, Puducherry.

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It has been brought to the notice of the undersigned that issue of number of Wound Certificates are pending for long time. Moreover, the Policemen are running from pillar to post to collect the opinion from concerned doctors. In this regard, instructions were issued earlier also that it is the duty of the doctor concerned to record the final opinion in the certificates. As far as possible the opinions have to be recorded in the Wound Certificate at the earliest in respect of patients who are treated as out-patients. In respect of cases admitted as in-patients for MLC, the opinion should be recorded immediately on discharge. It is the responsibility of the Resident Medical Officer to monitor the MLC cases on daily basis and obtain the final opinion and maintain the certificates in his office. The Police Department will approach only the Resident Medical Officer for pending certificates.
