Sir/Madam,

Kindly refer to this Department's letter of even No. dated 28.08.2018 on the subject cited above. Department of Personnel and Training has been organising Mid-Career Interaction between the Armed Forces and Civil Services Officers in collaboration with the Ministry of Defence for the last many years. The basic objective of this programme is to provide exposure of IAS/IPS/IFoS and other civil officers to the military to meet unforeseen situations at short notice.
