**PROCEEDINGS OF THE 34<sup>th</sup> GENERAL BODY MEETING OF  
THE PUDUCHERRY POLICE WELFARE SOCIETY HELD ON  
27.07.2016 AT 1600 HRS AT THE POLICE COMMUNITY HALL,  
GORIMEDU, PUDUCHERRY.**

The 34<sup>th</sup> Annual General Body Meeting of the Puducherry Police Welfare Society for the year 2015-2016 was held in the Police Community Hall at PAP Complex on 27.07.2016 at 16.00 hrs. The meeting was presided over by Shri Sunil Kumar Gautam, IPS, DGP (President), Shri Jagadeesan Kannan, IPS, IGP, Thiru A.K. Gawas, IPS, SSP(HQ) (Secretary), Thiru Konda Venkateswara Rao, SP(Training & Welfare) (Treasurer) and other members (100 police officers and 200 other ranks) attended the meeting. The last General Body Meeting was held on 19.12.2009.

As per Agenda No.1, SP (Welfare) read out the names of 14 police personnel, who expired during the period from 2015 to 2016 and two minutes silence was observed to mourn the death.

**AGENDA NO.2: ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT FOR THE YEAR  
2015-2016.**

SP (Welfare) read out the administrative report for the period from 2015 to 2016 which covered various functions and welfare activities of the society. Copy of the report was furnished to the members and after discussion the members approved the report.

**AGENDA NO.3: DISCUSSION ABOUT THE HIKE OF P.P.W.S.  
SUBSCRIPTION:**

SP (Welfare) read out the present and proposed rates of PPWS subscription for all ranks of Police as listed below, which were duly approved by the members.

**AGENDA NO.4: ENHANCEMENT OF SPECTACLES GRANT**

The present grant for Spectacles at Rs. 600/- per head twice in the service was reviewed as the same was fixed in 2009. It was proposed to increase the grant from Rs. 600/- to Rs.1000/- which was approved by the members

### **AGENDA NO.5: HIKE OF GRANT OF LOANS**

It was proposed to increase the loan amount granted from PPWS funds as below SGHC 2114 Kamaludeen requested to increase the proposed loan amount of 'Self Marriage' for Male members from Rs. 25,000/- to Rs. 40,000/- at par with female members. However, considering the financial position of the society and priority to be given to female members, the same was not considered and was fixed as Rs. 30,000/-. The members present agreed to the proposed revision.

### **AGENDA NO.6: HIKE OF RETIREMENT/DEATH GRANT**

It was proposed to increase the retirement grant from the existing amount of Rs. 15,000/- to Rs. 20,000/- and the death grant from Rs.15,000/- to Rs. 20,000/- . SGHC 2114, Kamaludeen requested to increase both the grants to Rs. 50,000/-. After discussions, it was decided to increase the retirement grant to Rs. 20,000/- and the death grant to Rs. 25,000/-. The members present agreed to the enhancement.

### **AGENDA NO.7: REVIVAL OF "SHILPI TEXTILE SHOP"**

Considering the welfare of the members of PPWS, it was proposed to revive the "Shilpi Textile Shop" by way of purchasing textiles during festival season like Deepavali and offering it to members in easy installments of Credit/Cash. However most of the members did not agree to this proposal and hence the same was dropped.

### **AGENDA NO.8: ENHANCEMENT OF WIDOW PENSION**

At present Widow Pension is given to 3 persons (2 in Puducherry & 1 in Mahe) who are widows of Police officials and who are not eligible for Government pension. It was proposed that the pension amount should be increased from Rs. 1,000/- to Rs. 1,500/- . This proposal was agreed to by the members.

### **AGENDA NO.9: REVIVAL OF THE TAILORING UNIT AT POLICE COMPLEX, PUDUCHERRY.**

It was proposed to revive the Tailoring Unit to stitch the uniforms and other dress materials of Police personnel by utilizing the services of the family members of Police personnel. This proposal was agreed to by the members present.

**AGENDA NO.10: PURCHASE OF A NEW XEROX MACHINE FOR PPWS OFFICE.**

It was proposed to purchase a new Xerox machine for PPWS office. The members have agreed to this proposal.

**AGENDA NO.11: ELECTION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF PPWS**

It was proposed to elect new executive members to the Executive Committee of PPWS. The below mentioned 6 members were elected unanimously.

**DISCUSSION OF POINTS OTHER THAN AGENDA:**

**INCREASING THE SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:**

It was proposed to increase the scholarship amount paid to the wards of Police personnel as follow:

SI Renil Kumar requested to increase the scholarship amount paid to M.B.B.S students to Rs. 500/-. But this request was not accepted considering the financial position of PPWS. The above proposed revision of scholarship was accepted by the members present.

**INSTALLING A.T.M. IN POLICE COMPLEX, GORIMEDU.**


SI Renil Kumar requested to arrange for installation of A.T.M. at Police Complex, Gorimedu for the convenience of Police personnel and their family members. DGP replied that already steps have been taken for the same and it would be done within two months.

DGP made the following announcements in the meeting.

- The proposals which were approved by the members as per the agenda would be implemented immediately and if any changes are required it would be done within few days after consultation with the members.
- Considering the 24 x 7 duties of police personnel, it was proposed to extend weekly off to the police personnel. To start with, the Beat Officers were granted weekly off.
- It is proposed to start a Children Park in the Police Complex, Gorimedu for the benefit of wards of Police personnel.
- It has also been proposed to develop a Garden with Benches to relax so that Police personnel and their families could relax in the Garden.
- As informed earlier, an ATM will be installed in the Police Complex at the earliest.
- A Crèche is proposed to be opened in the Police Complex for the benefit of the children of Police personnel.
- As discussed earlier, the Tailoring Unit will be made functional to stitch uniforms of police personnel and the dependents of Police families will be trained in tailoring and engaged in this work.
- A special workshop on Civil Services Examination will be organized for the benefit of the Wards of Police personnel and for the young police personnel aspiring for Civil Services.
- It has also been decided to conduct Basic and Advanced Computer coaching classes for the wards of police personnel.
- The library at Police Training School would be made accessible to all the family members of Police personnel so that they can utilize the library.
- Yoga classes will be conducted every Sunday for police personnel and their families at Police Community Hall between 06.00 and 08.00 hours.
- A new initiative of keeping the Police Stations – CLEAN, GREEN & SEEN has been announced.
  - CLEAN: All the Police personnel should keep their premises clean by clearing all the unwanted materials and rubbish.
  - GREEN: They should grow plants and trees wherever possible in the premises and ensure that the premises are green & environment friendly.
  - SEEN: They should hoist National Flag on the PS building so that they are seen distinctly to the public.

- As a part of SAVE LIFE CAMPAIGN a motorcycle rally was organized in Puducherry in which around 60 Police personnel took part by wearing helmets. DGP also advised that all police personnel and their family members should wear helmets while riding two wheelers and set an example to the general public.
- As an initiative to encourage wearing of helmets, Puducherry Police has announced that a list of persons wearing helmets will be taken and from them 10 persons will be selected through lots for visiting Paradise Beach with family on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2016.
- DGP stated that the crime rate is under control in Puducherry and the Police personnel should dedicate themselves fully. The beat system has been revamped and made effective. DGP warned that the Police personnel should not have any nexus with criminals. There will be zero tolerance towards the corruption. DGP wished that Puducherry Police should become the Best Police Force in India.
